LOT 51 - Vintage Mixed Lot of Tokens, Damaged Coins & Hollow Backed Pennies - Collectible Assortment



Description

This collection features a diverse assortment of tokens, damaged coins, and unique 'hollow backed' or center-holed items, providing insight into various historical uses from transit to amusement. The lot includes: 1. Transit Tokens: Several pieces are present, including 'GOOD FOR ONE FARE' tokens with fluted edges, one specifically identifiable as a 'CINCINNATI' transit token, and a classic 'GOOD FOR ONE ZONE FARE' token reminiscent of Chicago Transit Authority issues. These tokens are composed of various base metals, displaying significant circulation wear, toning, and some surface scratches consistent with their utility. 2. Amusement/Arcade Tokens: The collection contains multiple 'REDPOINT' and 'OPA REDPOINT' tokens, along with a distinct 'GOOD FOR M ONE LINE' token. These are generally made of copper or brass alloys and exhibit noticeable wear and some areas of original luster, though heavily circulated. 3. US Cents and Older Copper Coins: A variety of United States cents, including at least one discernible 'ONE CENT UNITED STATES OF AMERICA' (likely a

Lincoln cent), are part of the lot. Several other copper-colored coins, possibly including a large cent-style piece, show extreme wear, making specific denomination, country, mint year, and mint mark identification challenging without further examination. Many display heavy toning, significant scratches, and evidence of prolonged circulation or environmental damage. Some coins could be considered 'hollow backed pennies' due to severe wear or alteration, though a direct example of a physically hollowed penny isn't explicit, the term may refer to those with very faint or absent designs. 4.

Damaged & Unidentified Pieces: The lot also includes a distinctive silver-colored token or coin with an oblong central hole, indicative of either damage or a specific token design. Additionally, a large, irregular-shaped copper/bronze piece is present, showing severe abrasion and corrosion, rendering specific identification impossible. This piece exemplifies a 'damaged coin' due to its poor condition. None of the items in this collection have been slabbed or graded by a third party, and their condition ranges from heavily circulated to significantly damaged, with varying degrees of toning and surface marks., Condition: As-Is
